Non-laboratory Scholarship/Research Support Program (NSRP)	Provides funding for scholarship/research needs in disciplines not driven by instrument-dependent, lab-based research.	Up to \$20,000
METRIC Pilot Project Program (MPPP)	Provides matching funds to enable NC State researchers to access METRIC platform technologies.	Between \$2,000 and \$10,000 (one to one matching funds required)
Laboratory Research Equipment Program (LREP)	Provides funding for the acquisition, repair and/or replacement of shared equipment that may be located and maintained in NC State service centers, departments, colleges, or Centers and Institutes.	Up to \$25,000 (one to one matching funds required)
Faculty Research and Professional Development (FRPD)	Provides seed funding to individual investigators to jump-start larger awards and grants from outside agencies.	Individual award amounts are college dependent
